The Emergency and Uniformed Services sector can offer a very rewarding career pathway. With a diverse range of roles across areas of work such as the Police, Armed Forces, Fire Brigade and Ambulance Service, the industry is made up of important jobs that help to aid and protect the public.

Northern Ireland Fire and Rescue Service (NIFRS)

The NIFRS respond to fires, road traffic collisions and specialist rescue incidents, including flooding, chemical incidents, collapsed buildings, and other types of emergencies.

Find out what career opportunities are on offer in the <u>NIRFS</u>, a service who works in all areas of the Northern Ireland, all 5,500 square miles. Whether this is as a firefighter or in a support role.

- By working collaboratively with communities and those in the public, private and voluntary sectors to achieve their vision, being fully accountable to those who we serve.
